How are my Colbern Road envelope funds distributed?

The four funds on the offering envelopes are used for the following purposes:



OPERATING

The money in this fund is used for whatever is needed for the upkeep of our building and the many varied departments/programs we offer.

BUILDING

The money that is donated to this fund is used for permanent additions to our building and grounds. The money was used to build our current sanctuary, the stage outside as well as the playground. At the present time there are no plans for permanent additions.

TITHING

These funds are used for the missionary efforts of our branch including evangelism committee's outreach and also the various programs of the Conference of Restoration Elders (CRE) including: ARM, GEM, SEEAM and LAMB and special needs that arise from time to time within those organizations. We also use tithing money to help fund CPRS and Restoration Campus Ministries which are two missionary outreach programs for the youth of the church. The Book of Mormon Foundation also receives money from the tithing that is given.

OBLATION

This money is shared with those from within and outside our Branch to assist in meeting the financial needs of families and/or individuals including food, shelter, clothing, medical and utility bills. We also donate to community organizations such as Lunch Partners. Our Branch has voted that at the end of every year we will donate 20% of our year-end oblation balance to the Financial Stewardship Ministries, a program of the CRE. See the handout on the foyer table. All oblation requests are reviewed and handled anonymously through the Treasurer, including at times the assistant treasurer and the Pastorate. Individuals/families are not given cash/checks and members are not reimbursed if they choose on their own to donate to individuals/families or organizations.
