We will not rehearse on Sacrament Sundays.

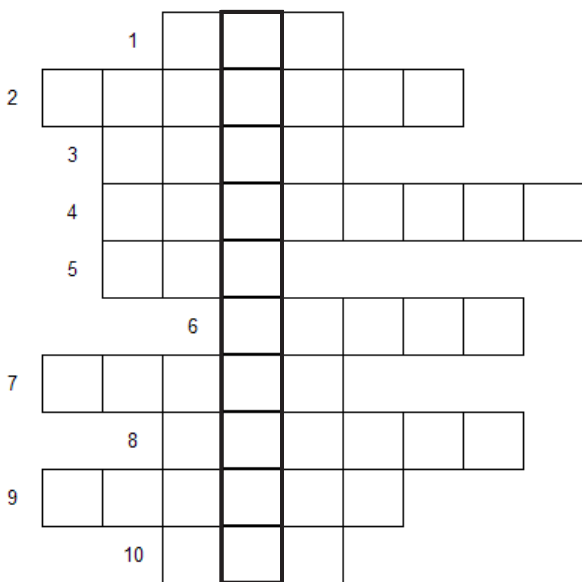
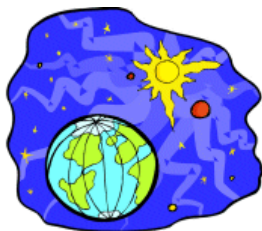
